FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

THIS GOTHIC-STYLE STRUCTURE IS THE SECOND OLDEST CHURCH BUILDING IN PULASKI, HAVING BEEN BUILT IN 1882

BROWN-DALY-HORNE HOUSE

BUILT IN 1855 AND PURCHASED BY GOVERNOR JOHN C. BROWN IN 1869. ONE OF THE FINEST EXAMPLES OF QUEEN ANNE-STYLE IN THE STATE

WILKINSON-MARTIN HOUSE

A FEDERAL STYLE HOME BUILT IN THE 1830S AND WAS IN THE WILKINSON FAMILY FOR 130 YEARS, ONE OF THE EARLIEST SETTLER FAMILIES IN THE COUNTY

ORIGINAL CHURCH OF GOD

A HISTORIC CHURCH BUILDING BUILT IN 1907, THE EARLIEST KNOWN CONGREGATION OF THIS AFRICAN AMERICAN PENTECOSTAL DENOMINATION IN THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

OUR NEOCLASSICAL COURTHOUSE WAS COMPLETED IN 1909, MARKED BY TALL CORINTHIAN COLUMNS AND A 1858 BELL STRIKING THE HOURS FROM WITHIN THE CUPOLA.

CAMPBELL CHAPEL AME CHURCH

A HISTORIC GOTHIC REVIVAL STYLE CHURCH WAS BUILT IN 1925 AND IS KNOWN FOR ITS EXCEPTIONAL STONE MASONRY

A HISTORIC DUTCH COLONIAL REVIVAL STYLE MANSION BUILT IN 1878 FOR POLITICIAN NEWTON HARRIS WHITE

FORMER ESTATE OF MARS CANDIES FOUNDER, FRANKLIN C. MARS, BUILT ON THE SUCCESS OF A 5 CENT CANDY BAR. THE LARGEST EMPLOYER IN GILES DURING THE GREAT DEPRESSION
